

Mildred Brading - Mary Alice Elam Scholarship Guidelines

These two scholarships honor an outstanding young man and woman in Arkansas FBLA who have demonstrated active participation in FBLA, academic ability, financial need, and career plans in a business field.

Eligibility

Each local chapter may enter one male and one female who are graduating seniors and have paid FBLA dues by the state deadline of the current year.

Regulations

- Applicants must upload the following to the google form provided by the state office:
 - A completed application
 - A resume not to exceed two pages
 - A transcript reflecting grades through the first semester of the current year and ACT or SAT test scores.
 - o Two recommendations from representatives supportive of the member's involvement in FBLA and school/community activities. Only one recommendation may be from an FBLA Adviser.
 - A short narrative stating your future plans and why you should receive this scholarship.

Criteria for Selection:

Career planning, financial need, FBLA activities, school and community activities, work experience, recommendations supportive of members involvement in FBLA, school, and community activities.

Judging

A committee will review the applicants for these scholarships. Decisions of the judges are final.

State Awards

Two \$400.00 scholarships (one male and one female), payable upon proof of college registration and attendance, will be awarded the winners.
